

RTW PROJECT UPDATE OCTOBER 2023

RTW is a federally funded research study that will provide autism evaluations to over 1,000 children enrolled in the Illinois Early Intervention (EI) program.

The problem: Long waitlists for autism evaluations for children enrolled in EI

Our goal: To find new and quicker ways to diagnose autism in young children. We want to make the autism diagnostic process efficient, accurate, and supportive for families of children enrolled in El.

Our approach: Increase the number of people qualified to provide an autism diagnosis (for example, early intervention clinicians, like speech and developmental therapists).

This quarterly report provides an update on our progress.

To date, **36 Illinois speech-language** pathologists and developmental therapists have participated in the RTW Project.

DIAGNOSTIC AGREEMENT

Between El providers (SLPs/DTs) with 20 hours of autism diagnostic training and RTW experts (clinical psychologist, SLP, DT) with a collective 10+ years of autism diagnostic experience.

RTW PROVIDERS

Agree that the RTW approach is a good way to diagnose autism

Agree that the RTW assessments are effective for diagnosing autism

Agree that the use of these assessments is consistent with the Illinois El mission

Providers to date were 97% Female, **14% Black, 3% Asian**, and **16% Latinx**.

67% of providers had no previous experience with autism screening tools.

98% would recommend participating in RTW to a friend in need of similar help.

95% agree with the diagnosis that was given for their child.

79% would be willing to use telehealth to complete a diagnostic assessment even if in-person assessments were available, based on the RTW experience.


