

# RTW PROJECT UPDATE MAY 2024

RTW is a federally funded research study that will provide autism evaluations to over 1,000 children enrolled in the Illinois Early Intervention (EI) program.

The problem: Long waitlists for autism evaluations for children enrolled in El

Our goal: To find new and quicker ways to diagnose autism in young children. We want to make the autism diagnostic process efficient, accurate, and supportive for families of children enrolled in El.

Our approach: Increase the number of people qualified to provide an autism diagnosis (for example, early intervention clinicians, like speech and developmental therapists).

This quarterly report provides an update on our progress.

86% DIAGNOSTIC AGREEMENT

El providers (SLPs & DTs) complete 20-hours of autism diagnostic training. Their diagnosis for each family is then compared to the expert research team (clinical psychologist, SLP, & DT) with years of autism diagnostic experience. We see that El providers are in agreement with the expert team 86% of the time.

Providers to date were **97% Female**, **17% Black**, **8% Asian**, and **15% Latinx**.

65% of providers had no previous experience with autism screening tools.


