Courses Taught

Northwestern University

CSD 458 Scientific Clinical Decision Making (Winter 2014, Fall 2015, Fall 2016, Summer 2017)

This course includes the exploration of current best evidence in making decisions about the assessment and treatment of individuals with communication disorders and an overview of different research methodologies. Emphasis is on the integration of research evidence and critical thinking into clinical practice. Students complete weekly group projects in which they apply the topic of the week to a specific research article or activity.

CSD 339 Early Communication Intervention with Infants and Toddlers (Winter 2014, Spring 2015, Winter 2016, Winter 2018)

This course provides information on issues and practices related to early intervention and working with families who have children with special needs. Topics include family and professional relationships, models of working with families, service coordination, family assessment and the IFSP, promoting family participation, coaching, media and technology and cultural considerations. Weekly lab assignments are video recorded clinical scenarios in which student analyze and apply the target skill for the week.

CSD 207 Seminar in Communication Sciences and Disorders: Communication: Beyond Talking (Spring 2014)

This seminar focuses on understanding barriers to communication for individuals with communication disorders from the different perspectives for individuals who have difficulty communicating (e.g., children with autism, adults with aphasia, people who stutter etc). Special attention is given to how communication disorders influences one's ability to engage in everyday life tasks and interactions. Students participate in weekly simulations and case-based learning activities to gain experience understanding the complexities and difficulties of having a communication disorder.

SPED 3030 Advanced Issues in Family Intervention (Fall 2011, Fall 2012)

This course covers information on issues and practices related to families with children who have special needs. Topics include definition and history of family, family and professional relationships, professional ethics, models of working with families, service coordination, family assessment and the IFSP, promoting family participation in the IEP, and IDEA.

SLP 5330 Research Methods in Communication Disorders (Spring 2013)

The purpose of this course is to provide research skills necessary to determine best clinical practice. The emphasis of this course is applied research methodology and the principles of evidence-based practice in communication disorders. This course provides an overview of different research methodologies as well as tools to evaluate the quality of different types of research studies.
