Screenings will be conducted by a graduate students under the supervision of an experienced developmental pediatrician. Parents will answer questions about their child's development in order to find out if their child is at increased risk for an Autism Spectrum Disorder. Each screening will take about 30 minutes. Information about resources and next steps will then be provided to families.

A diagnosis will not be made during this event, but children at increased risk for Autism will be referred for further evaluation.
