



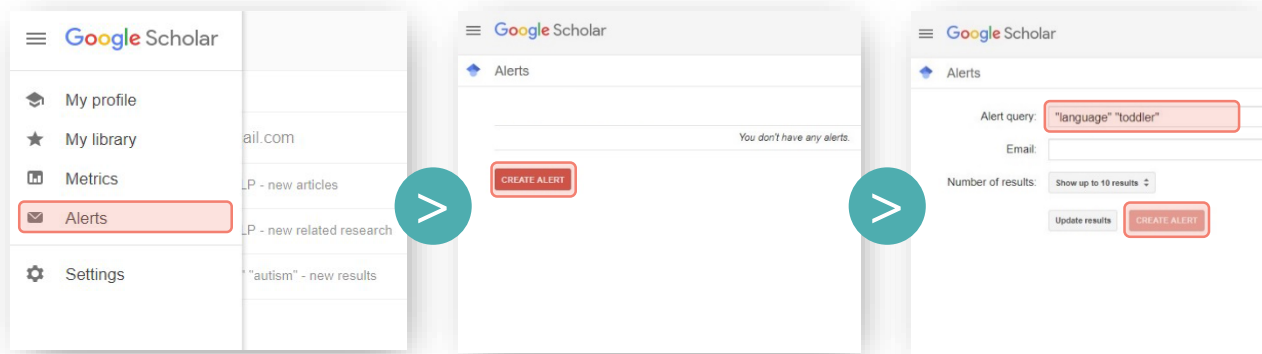
How to Set Up a Google Scholar Alert

What are Google Scholar alerts?

Once you set up a Google Scholar alert, Google will send you emails when relevant articles are published. You can set up alerts for specific researchers or topics that you are interested in so that you can stay up to date.

How do I set up a Google Scholar alert for topics I'm interested in?

1. Go to www.scholar.google.com



2. Select "Alerts" from the menu.

3. Select "Create Alert."

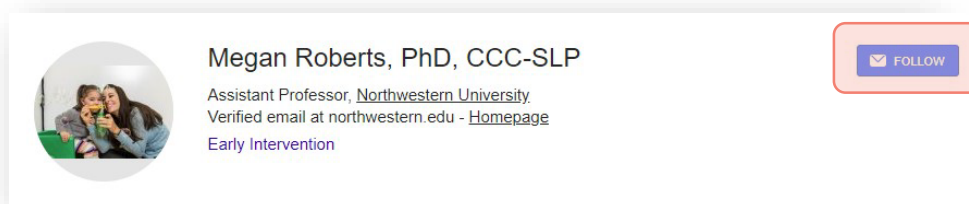
4. Enter all key words, using quotation marks, and select "Create Alert."

Some possible key words:

- "toddler"
- "language"
- "developmental language disorder"
- "autism"
- "child"
- "late language emergence"
